PRESIDENT & GENERAL MANAGER REPORT

2023 was an extremely successful year for BBI despite the challenges faced relating to the reinstatement of Auchenflower Stadium. In terms of the core business, we increased the number of games per week (+8 games), referee coverage (+4.4%), score bench coverage (+2.7%) and membership (+1,201). Membership growth was most significant in the Ford Aussie Hoops program and the 11-19 membership category. We took a strategic approach to increasing Aussie Hoops registrations by establishing more localised programs in targeted areas. We have focused on Referee Development and securing additional venues to support/enable the growth in the 11-19 membership category. In 2023, we established an exclusive hire agreement with Brisbane State Secondary College. We were also able to secure some other additional smaller venues. It is important to acknowledge the Junior Clubs and Schools who continue to support this fantastic growth.

A major project for the Management Committee was the Auchenflower Reinstatement project. With funding secured from the state and federal governments and the insurance claim settled, we could appoint our project manager (COHA) and architect (Open Architect). We were able to finalise a design that will create a level of resilience to future weather events and better meet the needs of the Members. In late 2023, we opened the tender and appointed a builder in early 2024. The appointed builder went into voluntary administration, impacting our timeline; we subsequently appointed iQ Construct as the builder for the works. With one eye to the future, we have also continued to build relationships with Local, State and Federal politicians as we look to secure management rights/leases for additional venues.

A significant highlight for the association was being named the Association of the Year by Basketball Queensland. This is just the 4th time in our history that we have won this award (2007, 2010, 2015). The criteria for this award review all areas of operation, including on-court performance, membership, officials, financial management and governance etc.



We would like to thank the Management Committee and Staff for their service in 2023. We would like to acknowledge departing staff members, Liam McInerney, who took on a new role at Waterpolo Australia, and Stephanie Collins, who became full-time with Basketball Queensland. We would also like to acknowledge the contributions of Thomas Coogan (10+ years), who most recently served as the Chair of the Community Engagement Action Group, and Robert Manson (5+ years who was active on the Finance Committee and Facilities Action Group in particular.

BRISBANE BASKETBALL REFEREE'S ASSOCIATION REPORT

Brisbane Basketball Referees Association has continued our working partnership with Brisbane Basketball. Together we have strived to improve our working relationship for our customers. The Culture of Brisbane Basketball Referees Association is to strive for continuous improvement within our Junior and Senior programs. Together we have worked towards improving the skill and knowledge of our referees and players. BBI and BBRA has identified this increase in commitment and have put in place a structure that we believe will meet these demands. BBRA In partnership with Basketball Queensland have worked towards continuous improvement and structured our education programs to meet the increased standards of our Junior, Social and GBL competitions. This past year our focus has been on the development of our education programs. BBRA has continued to provide Education Programs for our Junior, Senior and Representative Programs. We have always strived for continuous improvement in our retention and recruitment strategy designed to improve numbers and our on-court performance.

This past year Brisbane has gone through a process of restructuring their Referee Program. With our new structure the operational function of BBRA has been sectionalised into four segments These four segments are channelled towards providing Brisbane with a competent Referee Program

- BBRA has an Administration Officer in Michael Wiggins who has the responsibility of providing a fixture service to the Brisbane GBL and Senior Social Programs
- BBRA has an on court Game Senior Supervisor in Graeme Gray to monitor the GBL and Senior Fixtures
- BBRA's Junior Development Officer has the responsibility to structure the BBRA Junior & SQJBC Program
- BBRA must provide continuous improvement in skill and knowledge through their Education Officer

The junior program incorporates fixtures on Friday night and Saturdays. With the number of players committed to our Friday fixtures in numerous venues, we have always tried to meet the challenge of providing referee numbers to meet the demand. To date BBRA have conducted four Referee Beginner Courses to meet this demand. We have also conducted a Junior Referee Coaches Course.

Our Junior supervisors include Ash Cruickshank, Ben Camm, Kobie Low, Liam Hagarty and Shaun Pascoe . Our Junior Mentors include Jaida Lam, Nic Camm, Hayden Fogarty, Riley Fogarty and Nathan Pascoe. BBRA has a Junior Program to be proud off. Numerous Brisbane referees have achieved Gold and Bronze medal appointments at each State Championship and SQJBC Final series

With the new structure the appointment of our Social Referee Supervisor in Graeme Gray and the appointment of a BBRA Administration Officer in Michael Wiggins stability has been provided to BBI fixtures. BBRA provided Referee Education to our Social referees in February in preparation of a full year of fixtures.

The new structure included a new Tuesday Silver Competition Supervisor in Graeme Gray with support from one of our Mentors in Hayden Fogarty. The Silver Referees and the GBL Under 23 Referees panel's have been developed from Basketball Queensland's Under 18 State Championships where Brisbane Referees were awarded Gold and Bronze Medals in all grades. The Wednesday Gold Greater Brisbane League Competition is recognised as the best association competitions in the State.

Brisbane has 22 Referees on the NBL-1 and QSL Referee Panels who are part of the GBL Referee roster. Within the under 18 and under 16 State Championship Referees panels many have been selected for Basketball Queensland's Referee Development pathway program. These referees guarantee our future by increasing our Referee standards and future development. This participation builds teamwork

and comradery for our referees who will one day graduate onto the referee panels of Basketball Queensland's NBL-1 and QSL Competitions.

BBRA has a culture of supporting referees with an environment built on support for each individual who participates as a member of our association. In partnership with Brisbane Basketball we will continue to achieve our goals and objectives as we move into the year 2024-25.
